



Learn English through History and Culture

An all-year-round programme of combined morning English lessons and afternoon excursions to places of cultural interest in London

The Summer English Cultural Programme is an innovative educational programme for teens aged 11-15 with English language lessons which are thematically linked to afternoon excursions. Each day, students spend their morning class learning about and preparing for their afternoon educational visit to a local attraction or venue such as the Tower of London, Sea Life Aquarium or Science Museum.

Sample Week:	Morning English lesson: 09:15 – 12:00	Afternoon Educational Visit: 13:00 – 16:30
Monday	The Tower of London Famous kings and queens in the United Kingdom, and the history of the Tower of London.	
Tuesday	The Natural History Museum Endangered species and what can be done to protect them. Climate change and its effects on ecology.	
Wednesday	The London Bridge Experience The city of London in the past and present. The timeline of London's development and its importance in world trade.	
Thursday	The Houses of Parliament British politics and political history: how the UK is governed, and what are the current 'hot topics' in national politics.	
Friday	Madame Tussauds Celebrities and pop culture. The role that celebrities play in media and the effect they have on society.
